Task:

1. Choose a country you would like to visit, or, have already visited and enjoyed immensely.
2. Research that country's cuisine.
3. Research what their diet consists of, what type of food the people enjoy and eat.

Requirements:

Your restaurant menu must include:

- a minimum of three appetizers
- a minimum of three main course dishes
- a minimum of three dessert choices
- a minimum of three drinks
- Each item you put on your menu has to include a description of the item and a price.

Many restaurants have a theme, such as a sandwich shop, a waffle house, a pizza palace, or a steak shop etc. Decide if your restaurant will have a theme and what that theme will be.

Be sure to include realistic prices on your menu!

Your menu should be presented in an attractive and visually appealing manner, similar to what you might find in an actual restaurant.








Main Course
